##### **9.10.010 Skateboard free zone.**

The purpose of this chapter is to delineate a portion of this city in which certain activities shall be prohibited upon public property. (Ord. 5696 § 1 (part), 2002).

##### **9.10.020 Prohibited activities.**

(a) No person, while on publicly owned property within the skateboard free zone, shall ride upon or move about upon skateboards, roller blades, roller skates, scooters, or bicycles. (Ord. 5696 § 1 (part), 2002).

##### **9.10.030 Exceptions.**

(a) The operation of a bicycle upon the portion of the city street designed for vehicular traffic shall be permitted within the skateboard free zone, so long as all traffic laws are obeyed.

(b) The government official or body that is in control of public property within the skateboard free zone may grant specific exceptions to the prohibitions contained herein, so long as the granting of the exception is reduced to writing, executed by the appropriate official(s), and are limited to location, dates, and times. A document evidencing the granting of such exception shall be kept at the location where the excepted activities are occurring. (Ord. 5696 § 1 (part), 2002).

##### **9.10.040 Area designated.**

The area designated as the skateboard free zone shall be the area with a perimeter commencing at the intersection of the southern right-of-way line of 16th Avenue and the western right-of-way line of 7th Street; then running northerly to the northern right-of-way line of Kanerville Blvd.; then running northeasterly to the eastern right-of-way line of First Street; then running southeasterly to the southern right-of-way line of Pierce Street and then the eastern right-of-way Bluff Street to the southern right-of-way line of Fifth Avenue; then running westerly to the eastern right-of-way line of Main Street; then running southerly to the southern right-of-way line of 16th Avenue; then running westerly to the point of beginning. (Ord. 5696 § 1 (part), 2002).

#### **9.10.050 Penalty.**

Any person who violates a provision of this chapter shall be guilty of a simple misdemeanor and, upon conviction, shall be subject to the penalty provisions contained in Section 8.02.020. At the discretion of the city attorney, any violation of this chapter may be pursued as a municipal infraction according to the terms of Chapter 1.95, in lieu of criminal prosecution.
